#### **PROJECT OUTLINE**

Project Name: Relish 2009 Recipe Book

Participants: Restaurants in the City of Port Phillip Area

Duration: From Thursday November 5th 2008 until Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2009

- 3,000 copies produced

The total funds provided to the two charities is \$18,361.00 each (\$36,772.00).

The project is raising money for:



Sacred Heart Mission meals program which provides over 450 meals everyday from their meal centre in Grey Street St Kilda. The Rotary Club of St Kilda has a long history of supporting the meals area at Sacred Heart Mission, which dates back to Father Ernie Smith opening his doors to those in need in the local area. The SHM today provides an essential service to the local St Kilda community providing an extensive range of services that range from food services, to crisis support, medical assistance, supporting women, and aged care requirements as well as housing. The meals program has been operating for 26 years and provides a community hub for people who are experiencing isolation and loneliness.



Rotary International's ShelterBox project which provides humanitarian aid in the form of a green box which contains a ten person tent, thermal blankets, a multi fuel cooker, cooking and eating equipment, water purification tablets, collapsible water containers, a children's pack, tools and other basic equipment. ShelterBox deploys in disaster areas which have been effected by disasters such as earthquakes, cyclones and civil unrest. ShelterBox operates in countries near to Australia including Timor, Indonesia, Papua New Guinea and the Solomon Islands.

*Relish 2009* managed to attract sponsors and supporters for the production and launch of the book. As a consequence for every book sold, the entire proceeds from sales will be contributed to the two charities.
